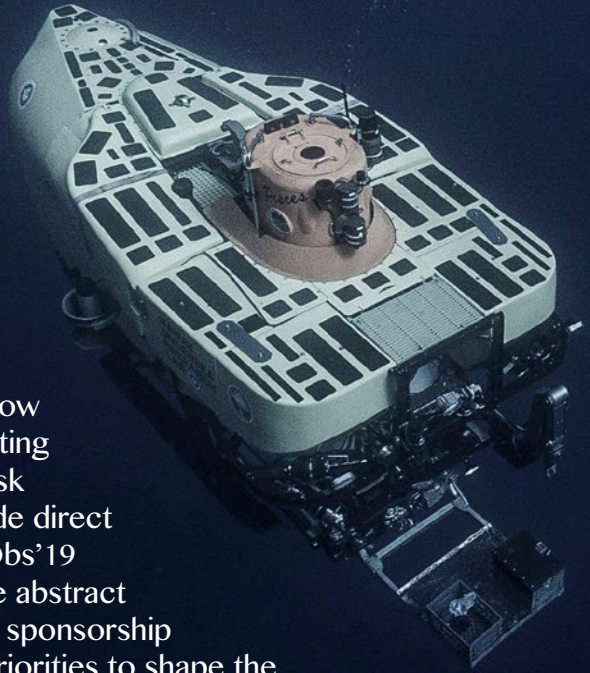
OceanObs'19: An Ocean of Opportunity Town Hall
